WATERMASTER UPDATES

Administrative Body Update:

Esther Rojas reported:

- Ms. Rojas reviewed the Administrative Body Report included in the meeting packet.
- Consolidated invoices for the Administrative Body and WRP were sent out on June 3rd. Please keep an eye out for the invoices and submit payment as soon as possible.
- The online Pumper Portal is under development. Training of use of the portal will be offered after volunteer participants complete beta testing. Hopefully, the portal will be rolled out to all pumpers by the Fall.

WBWRP Updates

Shawn Igoe:

- Meter Testing Contractors: The Panel received some responses for meter testing contractors and will work to compile a list of acceptable supplementary meter testing
- Mr. Igoe provided an update on meter testing contractors. He reported that he and Ron Sorensen are working on compiling a short list of alternate meter testing contractors and will share the list once it is finalized.
- The Panel discussed the issue of enforcement and will send a Letter of Non-Compliance to any pumpers in violation of their pumping rights and responsibilities.

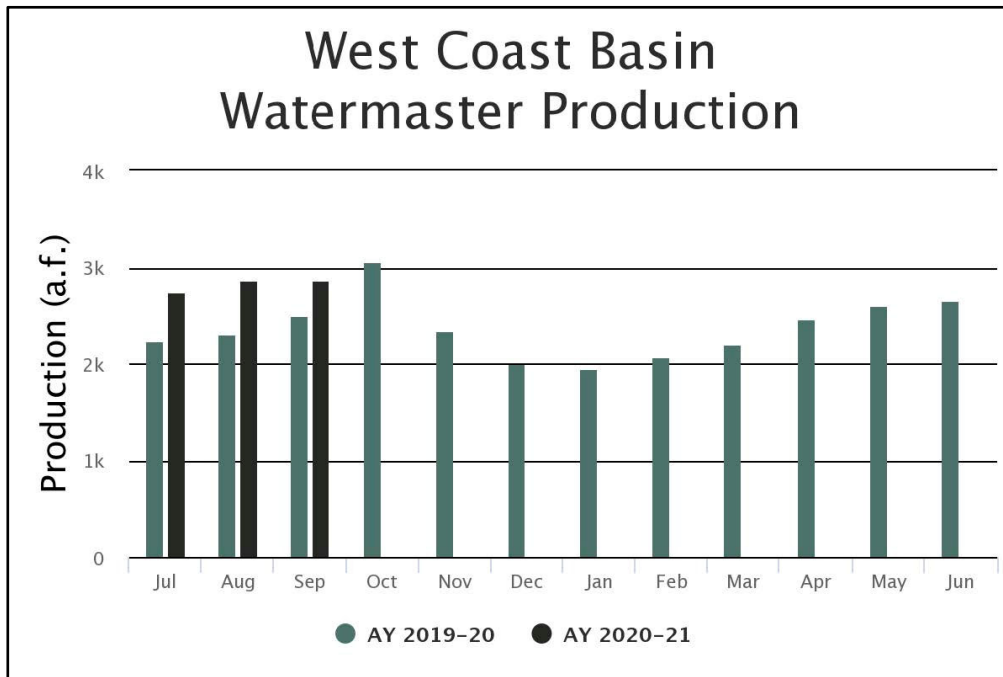

Groundwater Pumping

- For the Administrative Year (AY) 2020-21 Jul-Sep, West Basin groundwater pumping was 8,472.10, which is 1,412.90 acre-feet higher (or 20% more) than the same period in AY 2019-20. Various parties had a significant increase in pumping when compared to the previous AY, including Tesoro Refining & Marketing, Golden State Water Company, and City of Torrance. The tables attached provide detailed basin production and basin pumping trends by purveyor. The chart below summarizes and compares the AY 2019-20 and AY 2020-21 pumping.



Water Rights Activity

- For the AY 2020-21 Jul-Sep, there have been four leases processed transferring 3,203.50 acre-feet. All leases are with flex. The attached table gives details of these transactions.
- There have been no storage transactions for AY 2020-21.

Watermaster Budget

- The Administrative Body mailed out consolidated invoices on June 3, 2020 for AY 2020-21 with the Administrative Body’s and the Water Rights Panel assessments, including outstanding balances from

previous years. Staff is in the process of contacting parties with outstanding invoices. Attached is a list of outstanding payments.

Other Announcements

- The Administrative Body staff emailed the draft annual Watermaster Report for AY 2019-20 on October 15, in accordance with the Judgment. The draft is available on the WRD website under the “Watermaster- Administrative Body” tab. We ask that Party’s review the report and provide feedback to Ted or Esther by Friday, November 6 so that we can finalize the report. Per the Judgment, on or before December 15th the Watermaster needs to report to the court on the Basin, and for that purpose may adopt the Administrative Body’s report or may make its own report.
- On October 20, staff held a Pumper Portal Kick-off meeting for pumpers who volunteered to test the new Portal. Volunteers will test the Portal for two weeks and provide feedback to staff. The feedback will be used to improve the Portal and/or identify any glitches before making it available to the entire pumping community. We are expecting to roll out the new online Pumper Portal in early Winter. We will provide virtual training for all pumpers. This new tool will make monthly reporting much simpler for you and for us and will allow you to readily obtain the most current information on your water rights.
